## The Davis Companies hires Velocity Marketing Services to auction DNA Lofts

**Boston, MA** After acquiring DNA Lofts less than six months ago and completing significant enhancements to the property, real estate development firm The Davis Companies has hired Velocity Marketing Services (VMS) to conduct a real estate auction. The auction, set to take place on October 6th, will be for 25 loft-style condominiums at DNA Lofts, a newly constructed complex located in North Dorchester. Minimum bids start at \$115,000, up to 60% below last asking prices.

"With prices as high as they are in Greater Boston right now, and with such a limited inventory of newly developed condominiums, the auction for DNA Lofts brings a truly rare opportunity to prospective homeowners looking for affordable luxury alternatives in close proximity to Downtown Boston," said Sue Hawkes, president and CEO of Velocity. "The location will also be a great draw for buyers who want live in South Boston or the South End but don't want to pay the premium price."

The auction information center and model homes are open to preview daily through Oct. 6th at 944 Dorchester Ave. They will be open Mondays through Wednesdays and on Fridays from noon - 6:00 p.m., with extended hours on Thursdays from noon - 7:00 p.m. and on Saturdays and Sundays from noon - 5:00 p.m. Advance registration is required and financing is available for qualified buyers. There are neither buyer's premiums nor hidden reserves. The auction will be held on October 6th at 7:00 p.m. at The Colonnade Hotel, located at 120 Huntington Ave.

DNA Lofts is a unique conversion, transformed from a 1929 printing press into a 59-unit development, comprised of three connected, mews-style buildings. The historic, three-story brick building serves as an anchor for the property with two newly constructed four-story buildings flanking each side. All three buildings share the same roof line, creating a timeless look that blends old and new Boston. The property surrounds a landscaped and recently expanded private courtyard and patio with outdoor seating, which can serve as an entertainment space for community gatherings or larger events. Recently upgraded amenities also include a furnished roof deck with views of the Boston skyline and community room that is available for private owner functions.

"We purchased DNA Lofts at a price point that gave us the ability to completely update and reprogram the amenity spaces, and to finish unit improvements at a luxurious level," said Jonathan Davis, founder and CEO of The Davis Cos. Homes range in size from 655 s/f to 1,648 s/f with minimum bids ranging from \$115,000 to \$275,000. Minimum bids are up to 60% below last asking prices that ranged from \$212,875 to \$535,600. All winning bidders receive one outdoor deeded parking space and have the option to purchase garage parking instead.
